

DEFINITE ARTICLES = THE

- The Definite Articles is a fancy way to say “the” in English. In English “the” is “the”. But in Spanish there are four ways to say “the”. These ways depend on Masculine, Feminine, Singular and Plural.
- Masculine
 - As you remember from a previous lesson, if the last letter of a singular noun ends in L,O,N,E,R,S there is a 97% chance that the word is Masculine.
 - If a noun is masculine and singular the word “the”= el
 - If the word is masculine and plural the word “the” = los
- Feminine
 - If the last letter of a singular noun ends in D,ión,Z,A there is a 98% chance that the word is feminine.
 - If a noun is feminine and singular the word “the” = la
 - If the word is feminine and plural the word “the” = las
