

SINGULAR & PLURAL RULES

- Rule 1: if the word ends in a vowel, add “s”.
- Rule 2: If the noun ends in a consonant, add “es”.
- Rule 3: If a noun ends in a “z”, change the “z” to “c” and then add “es”.
- Rule 4: If a noun ends in “s”, sometimes we add “es” and sometimes we don’t add anything. Only experience with the language will let us know (or I’ll tell you).
