Directions: Read my interpretation of the symbols in this song. Notice the number of cognates (Words that are spelled about the same, pronounced about the same and most importantly mean the same in both languages. In this example, about 27% of the words are cognates.) See how many words that you already know in Spanish, but just didn't realize it! Each word that is in bold print is the Spanish word!

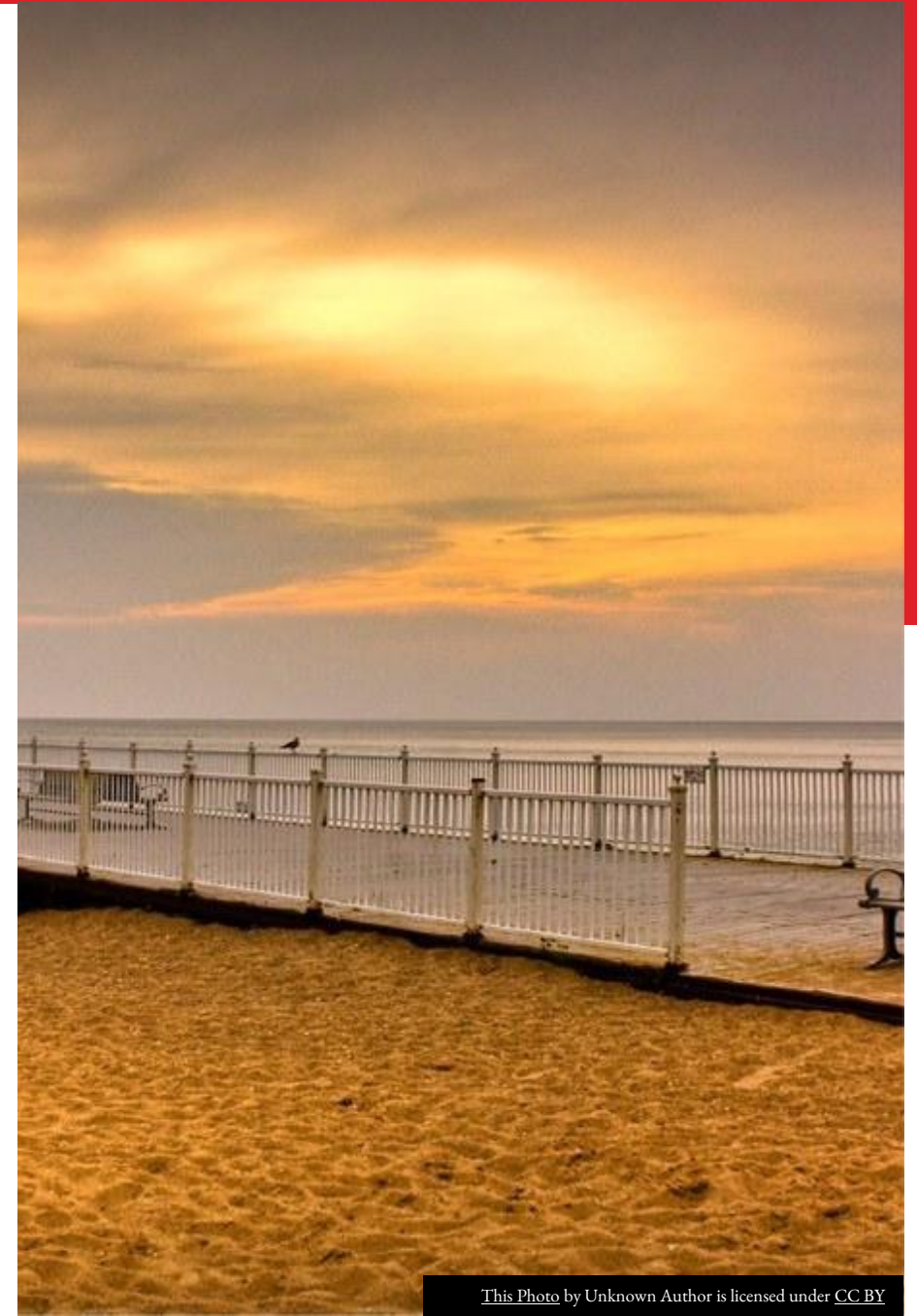
The **símbolos** of this song:
