Act. 10: There are three types of “Stem-changing Verbs” in Spanish. We will learn how to do “e to ie” Stem-Changing Verbs. There is a pattern for these verbs. It requires us to make two changes to these verbs, one in the stem or front part of the verb and the other like all the other verbs on the AR, ER, or IR endings. Not all verbs are stem-changing. We will know which ones only by experience with the language, with me telling you, or if you see (ie) in parenthesis after the verb in an exercise or in the dictionary. There are several e-ie stem-changing verbs in our vocabulary list today. Look for the “(ie)” after the verb.

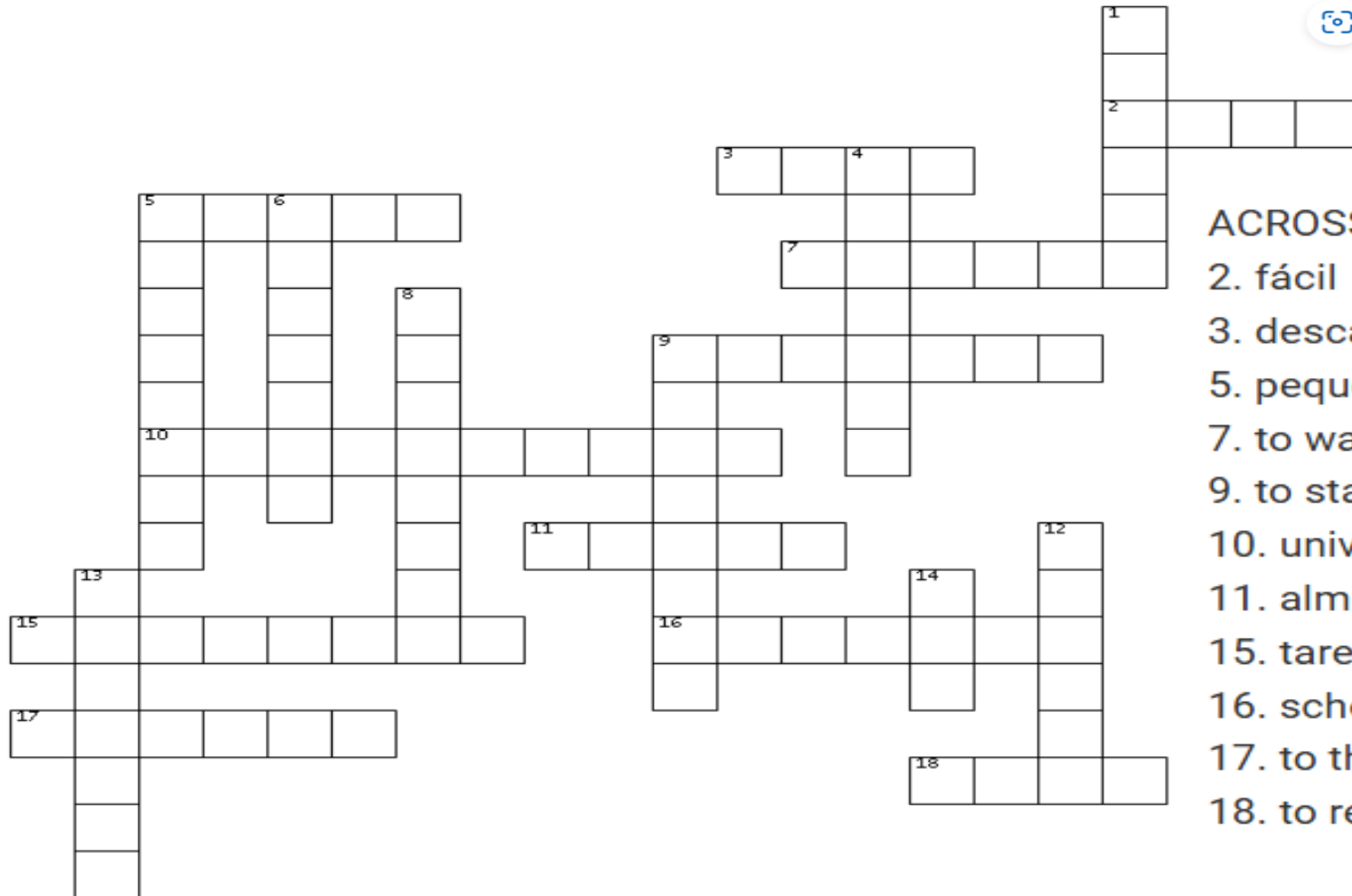
