

29. Reflexive Verbs

There are some verbs in Spanish that are called Reflexive Verbs. They can be used in all verb tenses. There are three basic reasons why these verbs are considered to be Reflexive:

1. The person doing the action of the verb is affected by that same action. In other words, the person is doing the action to oneself.

Examples:

lavar = to wash the dishes, car, etc... **lavarse** = to wash yourself

sentar (ie) = to seat a child etc.. **sentarse** (ie) is to seat oneself

2. Two or more people are doing a reciprocal action to each other.

Example:

Comprender = comprehend job, language, etc... comprenderse= understand each other

Besar= to kiss the baby, picture, etc... Besarse= to kiss each other

3. Sometimes, a verb in Spanish has 2 different meanings, one is assigned to be a regular verb and the other is assigned to be reflexive.

Examples:

Ir = to go

Comer = to eat

irse= to go away, leave

comerse= to devour

Reflexive Verbs need to have 2 words when they are conjugated, 1- a Reflexive Pronouns and 2 the Verb conjugated in the appropriate tense. (Reflexive Verbs work in all verb tenses)

Myself = me	Ourselves = nos
Yourself = te	Yourselves (Spain) = os
Himself = se	Themselves = se
Herself = se	Yourselves (not Spain) = se
Yourself (Ud.) = se	
Itself = se	

When the verbs are conjugated the Reflexive Pronoun goes before the verb.

Examples: Present Tense

me lavo	nos lavamos
te lavas	os laváis
se lava	se lavan

Examples: Preterit Tense

me bañé	nos bañamos
te bañaste	os bañasteis
se baño	se bañaron

Examples: Imperfect Tense:

me sentaba	nos sentábamos
te sentabas	os sentabais
se sentaba	se sentaban

Example for Reflexive Pronouns with Infinitives:

Yo quiero levantarme	Nosotros queremos levantarnos
Tú quieres levantarte	Vosotros queréis levantaros
Ella quiere levantarse	Ellos quieren levantarse
